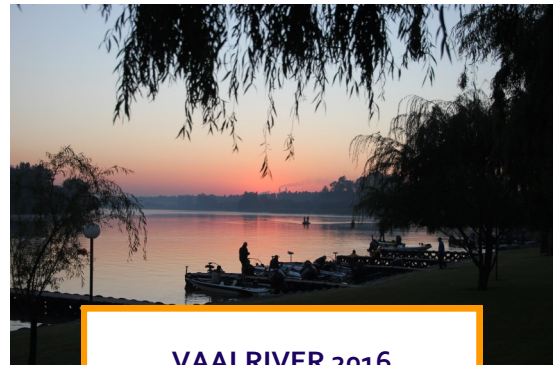

Japie, please accept our sincerest gratitude for the superior work you have done.



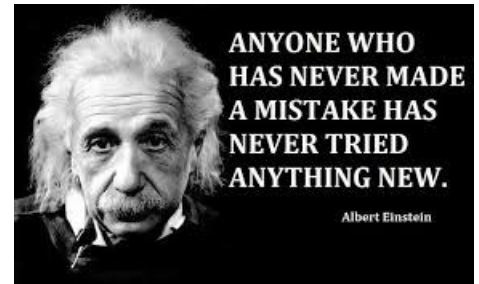
## SASACC Training
